Sidewalk Assessment Procedure – Summary **

- 1. City Council identifies need for sidewalks within area or areas of concern.
- 2. City Council takes official action to order in sidewalk.
- 3. Develop preliminary project cost estimate.
- 4. Notify Property Owners to construct sidewalk at their own expense and within designated time.
- 5. a. Create Resolution of Necessity for installation of sidewalk and to assess costs to property owners.
 - b. Identify funding source(s) and secure funding.
- 6. Prepare Plans and Specifications for sidewalk construction project.
- 7. Send proposed Resolution of Necessity to property owners.
- 8. Advertise for bids.
- 9. Award bid, provide Notice to Proceed and complete installation of sidewalks.
- 10. Develop Assessment Roll based on final project costs.
- 11. File Assessment Roll with City Finance Officer.
- 12. Finance Department sends assessment bill to property owners.
- 13. Payment of assessment completed in accordance with repayment options.
