(160 out of 216 (74%) stated they have been homeless 3 times or less - 45 or 21% stated 4 times or more and are considered chronically homeless.)



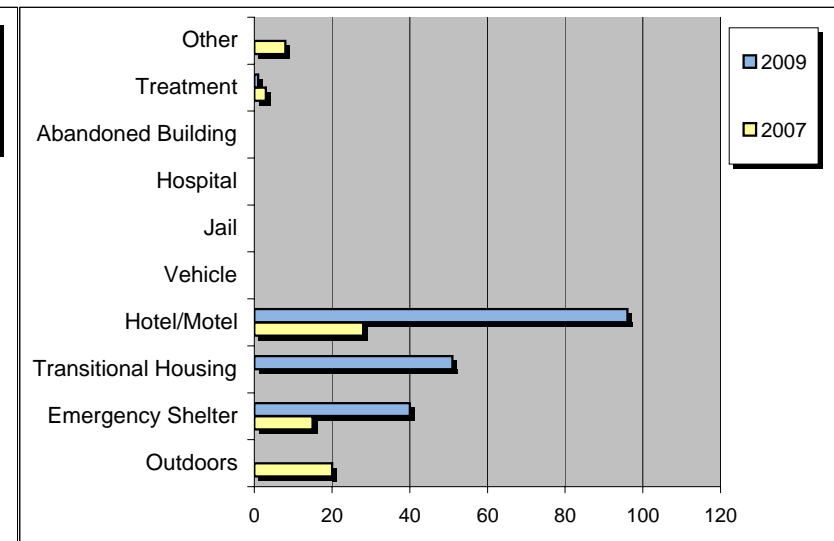
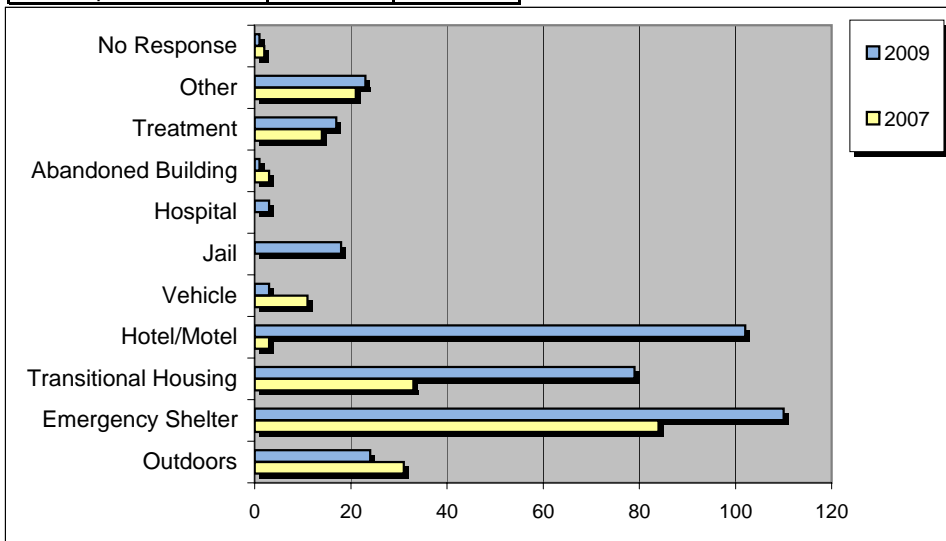

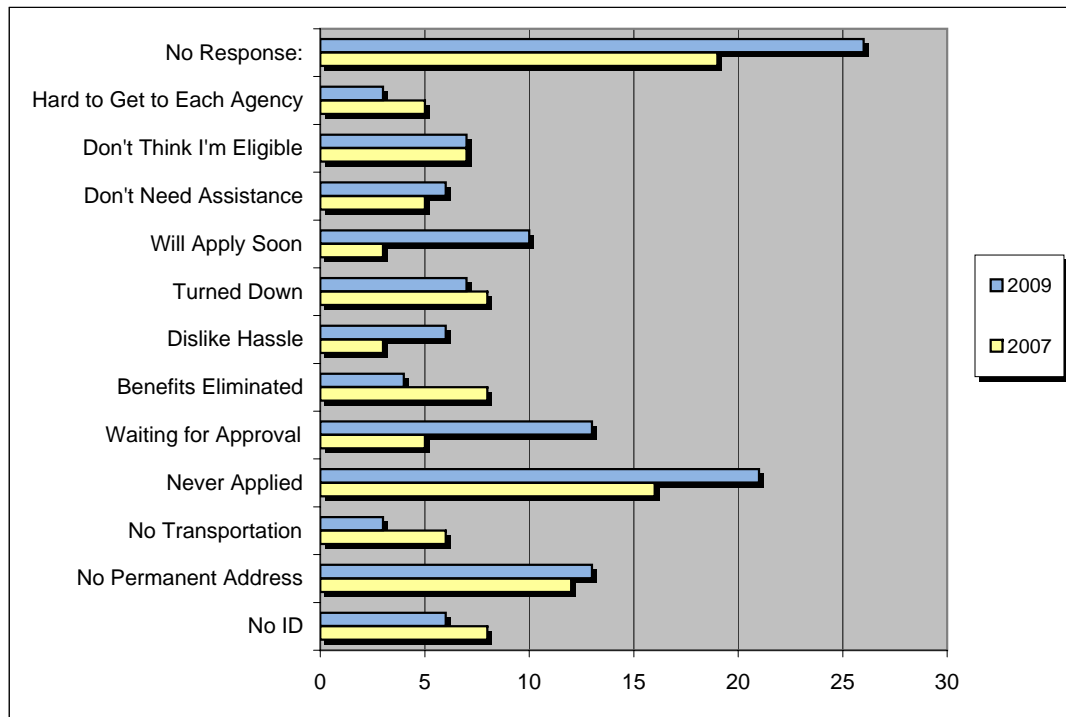

### How much monthly income do you receive (survey only - 216)

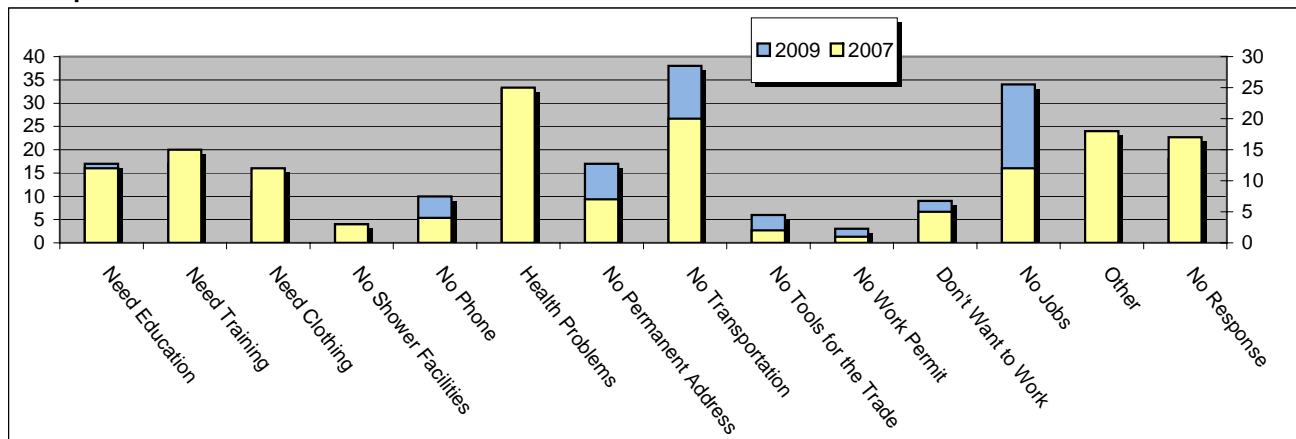
