



# 40<sup>th</sup> Annual Rapid City Clean Up Day April 24, 2010

April 24<sup>th</sup> **City-Wide Clean-Up Day**: Citizens and organizations clean up public areas of Rapid City – **To volunteer and sign up a group or for more information, contact the Rapid City Mayor's Office 394-4110.**

**Rapid City Pride**: Businesses are encouraged to clean up sidewalks, entrances, parking lots, and alleys during the week and Saturday.

**April 19 through April 24<sup>th</sup> NO CURB SIDE PICKUP**. Free disposal at the landfill. Area residents using private vehicles, (such as cars, pickups, and small trailers) may haul items to the landfill on S. Hwy 79 --Hours are 7 am to 4:45 pm Monday/Saturday - **ALL LOADS MUST BE SECURED** **No household hazardous waste will be allowed at the landfill**--Visit the City of Rapid City Solid Waste Department Web page for information on disposal of items such as oil and paint- [http://www.rcgov.org/pubworks/solidwaste/special\\_waste\\_handlers.pdf](http://www.rcgov.org/pubworks/solidwaste/special_waste_handlers.pdf)

**Tire Disposal**: COST: 16" or smaller \$2.98 per tire ---- Tire on rim or larger than 16" - \$9.28 per tire. Tractor or other large tires are \$259.70 per ton (tax included in prices) – **ALL TIRE DISPOSALS MUST STOP AT SCALE.**

**White Goods**: **Pacific Steel & Recycling** will pay for all white good and will accept and certify all Freon bearing appliances at no cost from April 19 to April 24. They will be open from 8 am to 2 on April 24<sup>th</sup> for white goods only. Contact them for further details on discarding additional items. **Karl's TV & Appliance** will do Freon removal certification from appliances, like refrigerators, freezers and dehumidifiers for a cost of \$47.70. Contact them for further details on discarding additional items. **K&D Appliance Service** will do Freon removal at a cost of \$47.70 per certification. Contact them for further details on discarding additional items.

**No appliances will be accepted at the landfill**

**Trash to Treasure Exchange at Landfill**: Saturday, April 24 –The public is invited to bring usable items to a special area at the landfill on **Saturday only** - these items will be available for free on **Saturday, April 24<sup>th</sup> only.**

**Yard Waste Compost Sale**: April 19<sup>th</sup> to April 24<sup>th</sup> at the Regional Recovery and Landfill Facility (RALF) on S. Hwy 79 from 7 AM to 3 PM each day. Prices are \$20 for large pickup and \$10 for small pickup load.

**Neighborhood Cleanups**: **Absolutely no tires, appliances, automotive products, paints or yard waste are allowed at or in dumpsters.**

**April 24-25**: Food Bank at 814 Maple Avenue - 625 Crazy Horse Street and 625 Sitting Bull Streets
