David Schram served in the United States Marines Corps from November, 1968 to November 1971. His basic training and infantry training was in California then to Vietnam from June 1969 to August 1970 as a Corporal E-4 providing convoy security and engaging the enemy when necessary. David was stationed at DaNang Vietnam during his war time duty. He was honorably discharged in November 1971 earning the US Vietnam Service Medal and VCM.

David is a volunteer at the Rapid City Vet Center and has served two and three days a week for the past fifteen years.
