Winfred "Doc" Jackson, Jr. !**



In partnership with the Veterans Coordination Commission, we are pleased to present the February, 2010 Veteran of the Month Recognition to Winfred "Doc" Jackson, Jr.

Mr. Jackson entered the United States Army in April, 1968 and arrived in Vietnam in October, 1968 as a combat medic with the 1st & 28th Infantry Regiment. He was wounded in February in 1969 and left Vietnam in September of that year. Mr. Jackson continued to serve in the United States Army as a medic until 1983 when he was released with a medical discharge.

Mr. Jackson received a Silver Star, Bronze Star, Purple Heart, Air Medal, Vietnam Service Medal w/4 bronze stars, Vietnam Cross of Gallantry, Vietnam Campaign Medal w/60 Device, Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Medals and the Combat Medical Badge.

Mr. Jackson is a Life Member of the DAV and Military Order of the Purple Hearts. He constantly volunteers at the DAV and helps with the Americanism program at area schools, day cares and various organizations. Mr. Jackson was the 2009 Buffalo Chip Rally Veteran of the Year. He serves as Sgt. of Arms for the DAV and as Adjutant for the MOPH.

Mr. Jackson has served his country with honor and integrity.
