Note: All trees should have a 4 foot diameter mulch base with an 18 inch diameter "bowl" around tree trunk. Shrubs should have a 3 foot diameter mulch base with a 8 inch diameter bowl at the trunk. Native grass, gravel or turf grass may be used around the mulch base.
