RE: Bid Negotiation Summary of Changes to Project

The purpose of this memo is to summarize the scope changes and cost savings to the project from negotiations between the Owner (City of Rapid City) and the Contractor (Complete Contracting Solutions).

Bid Item 17 – 5" Post-Tensioned Concrete Courts with Acrylic Surface

(No Change in Scope of Work)

Cost savings was achieved by having the local Contractor (Complete Contracting) provide support alongside the Post-Tensioned Concrete Subcontractor.

Bid Item 34-42 – Storm Sewer System

Cost savings was achieved by revising the proposed storm sewer system. The storm sewer system was revised as necessary to provide the use of a trench drain system to convey stormwater runoff flows in lieu of storm sewer pipe.

Quantities for Bid Items 34 - 42 were revised as shown below.

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A lump sum quantity for Bid Item <u>42.5 - 8" Trench Drain and MISC. Concrete</u> was added to the Contract to accommodate the revised changes to the storm sewer system. See attached Sheet C13R-Revised Storm Sewer System

Bid Item 58 – Exterior Athletic Lighting (Base BID)

Cost savings were achieved by having the local Contractor (Complete Contracting) provide the foundation installation and by revising the light pole layout to remove 4 light poles. Additionally, the Musco light poles and light fixtures material furnishing was removed from the scope of work. Installation of the Musco light poles and light fixtures remain in the scope of work. The City plans to furnish the Musco light poles and light fixtures for the project after the project is awarded by City Council.
