Dear KTM Design Solutions,

The request to waive the requirement to install 34' of pavement in Muirfield Drive is <u>approved</u>. No parking signs must be provided by the developer on both sides of the street.

The request to waive the requirement to install sewer main in Muirfield Drive is denied.

For pavement, subdivision improvements including pavement, curb, gutter, sidewalk, street light conduit, water main and sewer main are triggered during the platting process for all adjacent roadways. The proposed Red Rock Shadows plat for Tract B has frontage to Muirfield Drive for approximately 360'. Muirfield Drive is a collector street on the City's Major Street Plan and is an existing improved right-of-way. The existing pavement width is 27', meeting the requirements for a collector street with no parking. The proposed plat is for a larger lot (13 acres) assumed to be for an MDR use, of which parking would be provided onsite. On street parking does not appear to be necessary adjacent to Tract B. No parking signs must be provided by the developer on both sides of Muirfield Drive.

For sewer, the Rapid City Infrastructure Design Criteria Manual Section 3.5.5 states "Sewer mains shall be extended across the full frontage of each parcel to be served, except... when the City determines that no possibility exists that the main will need to be extended to serve adjacent property." The adjacent properties along Muirfield Drive to the south on both the east and west sides of the road need sewer main extended in Muirfield Drive from the north in order to have gravity sewer service. Topography limits gravity sewer to coming from the north to serve this area. The developer is responsible to extend sewer across the full frontage of their property so that it is available to service neighboring properties. Therefore, sewer main needs to be extended with this project. The nearest sewer main is located in Muirfield Drive approximately 450' to the north of the northwest property corner so extension of sewer main only adjacent to proposed Tract B would construct a dry sewer main. As the developer owns land to the south that will need public sewer from Muirfield Drive, proposed Tract C, it is recommended that sewer be constructed to connect to the existing main in Muirfield Drive with this project making it an active

sewer main. It is assumed that sewer service for proposed Tract B would come from the existing main in Portrush Rd.

The denial of this exception request may be appealed to the City Council by requesting it be placed on the next Public Works Committee agenda. The City Council has final approval of exception requests. In order to appeal the denial the applicant shall file a written request of appeal to the Public Works Director within 10 working days of the denial. Please contact the Public Works Engineering Department if you desire to appeal.
