627 Main Street (18SN008)

Applicant: Patrick and April Eaton

District: Downtown Commercial Historic District – Non-Contributing – built c.a. 1898

Request: Install 4' x 2' wall sign and a 3' x 2' pedestrian sign for RTR Wood Carvers, non- illuminated.

Hanzel advised that she encouraged the applicants to attend the meeting and to bring in color samples for the committee to review.

**Fenhaus moved to approve the installation of a non-illuminated 4' x 2' wall sign and a 3' x 2' pedestrian sign for RTR Wood Carvers at 627 Main Street. The motion was seconded by Jackson.**

Jackson expressed concern about the brightness of the proposed sign colors.

Blada expressed concern that the copy on the wall sign is hard to read. Fenhaus and Jackson concurred. A brief discussion followed.
