Dear Mr. Sagen,

The purpose of this letter is to outline our agreement for the engine repower of seven Rapid City transit busses. Navistar has agreed to replace the MaxxForce 7 engines and aftertreatment of these busses with Cummins ISBs and a selective catalyst reduction aftertreatment system. The engine repower work will be conducted at the Navistar facility in Madison Heights, MI and will be completed by Navistar technicians.

The engine that will be installed will be a 2017 Model Year Cummins ISB 6.7L at 260 HP with a Cummins Emission System PN A055B017 single can aftertreatment device.

At the completion of retrofit of the seven busses, Navistar will invoice the City of Rapid City \$190,000.00 and Navistar will be responsible for all additional costs including transportation of the busses from Rapid City, SD to Madison Height, MI and back.

Completion of the retrofits is estimated to be the week of April 16th 2018.
