**Proposed FY 2019 Community Development Block
Grant Recommended Funds**

The City of Rapid City is soliciting public comments on the proposed funding allocations for FY 2019 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds.

City Council has given preliminary approval for FY 2019 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding allocations. The City has CDBG funding requests totaling \$2,047,860.88. Preliminary allocation recommendations are based on estimated FY2019 CDBG funds. Recommended funding allocations include Behavior Management Systems (\$46,800), Pennington County Health & Human Services, (\$25,000), Black Hills Works (\$99,687.88) and Black Hills Community Loan Fund (\$30,000). Comments on the proposed FY2019 CDBG Funds will be received until 4:00 p.m. on February 11, 2019. All comments received will be considered and any changes warranted will be made to the plan at the Legal & Finance meeting on February 13, 2019, for final approval of the City Council in February 18, 2019.
