Blada called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

SIGN APPLICATIONS

200 Main Street (18SN023)

Applicant: Rosenbaum's Signs

District: Environs of an Individually Listed Structure (The Creamery Mall)

Request: Pylon sign with internally illuminated cabinet (5' x 7'2") and electronic message center (3'8" x 6'9"); 6' x 6' wall sign (illuminated); 3'6" x 43'6" wall sign (illuminated).

Hanzel reviewed the application and drawings for the request.

Willey informed the committee that the signs are a little smaller but similar to the other signs located at their other bank locations.

Roseland moved to approve the pylon sign with internally illuminated cabinet (5' x 7'2") and electronic message center (3'8" x 6'9"), the illuminated 6' x 6' wall sign and the illuminated 3'6" x 43'6" wall sign at 200 Main Street. The motion was seconded by Miller.

Willey provided sign samples and noted that the channeled letters and the logo on the pylon sign will be backlit.

In response to a question from Hanzel, Willey reviewed the location of the proposed signs.

A brief discussion followed regarding the requirements for signs being located in the environs.

The motion to approve the pylon sign with internally illuminated cabinet (5' x 7'2") and electronic message center (3'8" x 6'9"), the illuminated 6' x 6' wall sign and the illuminated 3'6" x 43'6" wall sign at 200 Main Street carried with Roseland, Blada and Miller voting yes and Jackson abstaining.
