The Rapid City Convention and Visitors Bureau and the Rapid City Parks and Recreation Department has committed to hosting a Gus Macker event in our community for the next three years. The Gus Macker 3 on 3 Basketball Tournaments are designed so that anyone can play: male or female, young and old, short and tall, the most experienced or no experience at all. This maintains the purity and integrity of the "driveway game". The tournament started in 1974 by Scott McNeal (alias Gus Macker) on his parents' driveway basketball court in Lowell, Michigan. As a national brand, Gus Macker works with local host committees to provide a great, outdoor 3 on 3 basketball experience by providing critical support for the tournament. Right now we are projecting to have around 600 participants, many local, but also many from outside Rapid City as there is not another Gus Macker Tournament within 650 miles of Rapid City.

It is our intention to host this event in downtown Rapid City on 6<sup>th</sup> Street with 7<sup>th</sup> street as contingency depending upon the number of teams we acquire. As you can see from the enclosed map, we do not intend to shut off any east to west streets within the downtown corridor. We have contacted several businesses that will be affected and will accommodate to the best of our abilities any special consideration that are needed.
