Dear Ms. Star Comes Out:

The Library Board considered your appeal of your six-month library suspension, and the incidents that resulted in that suspension. Your appeal was denied, and as a result, your suspension remains in force.

Therefore,

You may not be on the property of the Rapid City Public Library until June 4, 2020, and you are subject to citation or arrest for trespass if you violate this suspension.

The reasons for the denial:

- Although you stated you have never been suspended from the library before, that is not the case
 - You were removed from the library on November 3, 2019 due to intoxication, and on November 5, 2019 due to intoxication and violation of your suspension
 - You were suspended from the library for one month, from November 4 – December 4, 2019
 - You were also suspended for one week, from December 2 – December 9, 2018

You noted in your appeal that you need to use the library's computers for college papers. Your college should provide you with the opportunity to use their computers. If you are taking classes online, and can obtain a verification to that effect, you may be able to use the computers at WDT or the School of Mines.

We will certainly welcome you to return to the library after that date. As with all library users, you will be expected to abide by the library's policies; if you do not do so, you will be subject to another suspension term.
