





This letter is to express my support for the proposed parking lot improvements at the Club for Boys.

As these improvements are located on Rapid City Greenway Tract 22, dedicated to Public Park Use via the Greenway Plats of 1979, we must be mindful of proposals coming forward that could affect that Public Park Use designation. I am glad to see that the proposal calls for only paving the existing gravel lot and will not encumber any additional greenway parkland for parking.
