

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-091

A RESOLUTION EMPHASIZING INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SECURITY

WHEREAS, government entities at the Federal, State and local levels have increasingly become the targets of sophisticated malicious cyber-attacks that compromise the security and integrity of government operations; and

WHEREAS, collaboration and information sharing between government, law enforcement and private stakeholders will enable the City to better assess cyber threat levels and protect its residents from such threats; and

WHEREAS, standardizing the City's cyber defense and response strategies in coordination with non-City governmental bodies, law enforcement and the private sector will enhance the City's ability to respond to cyber-threats in a cohesive and comprehensive manner; and

WHEREAS, providing a secure network environment requires the implementation of a centrally managed set of security controls, policies and procedures that are implemented on all network and computer resources owned and operated by the City; and

WHEREAS, protecting the City's information infrastructure is vital to its continued operations and to ensuring the health, safety and welfare of its residents; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council that the City of Rapid City shall protect the City's network and computer resources through a centrally managed set of security controls, policies and procedures to ensure compliance with the Center for Internet Security Critical Security Controls implemented on all network and computer resources owned and operated by the City; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Common Council authorizes the Mayor and Information Technology Department Director to do all acts necessary to implement this Resolution in accordance with state law.
