Location: 600 Main St – metered parking

Violation: Overtime Parking – expired meter

Citizen’s reason for appeal: “Receipt of no credit paid toward meter”

Reason for upholding citation: “Not sufficient evidence. If you have documentation of payment, please send to parkingmanager@rcgov.org for resolution.”

Note: Upon further discussion with the citizen, it appears she is not contesting that the meter was expired, but is contesting the City’s legal right to regulate parking in the downtown area.

Violation: Overtime parking – expired meter

Citizen’s reason for appeal: “Loading zone was blocked by city worker.”

Reason for upholding citation: “This citation is valid and will be upheld. See Rapid City ordinance below:

Rapid City Municipal Code 10.44.050 Parking by expired meter.

It is unlawful for any person to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle owned or operated by him or her to be upon any street within a parking meter zone in any space adjacent to which a parking meter is installed, for any time during which the meter is showing a signal indicating that the space is illegally in use, other than such time as is necessary to operate the meter to show legal parking.”
