Motion was made by Frankenfeld and seconded by Winkler and carried **to authorize the Finance Officer to issue warrants or treasurers checks, drawn on proper funds, in payment thereof.**

Miscellaneous:

1) Executive Session

Motion was made by Winkler and seconded by Frankenfeld **to go into executive session for the purposes permitted by SDCL 1-25-2 (1), (3), and (4).** Upon vote being taken, the motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Bailie and seconded by Frankenfeld **to come out of executive session.** Upon vote being taken, the motion carried unanimously.

Breuninger then Sterling left during Executive Session.

Motion was made by Frankenfeld and seconded by Winkler **to hire the Accounting Clerk II position at Grade 11 Step 6.** Upon vote being taken, the motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Winkler and seconded by Frankenfeld **to approve the creation of an additional FTE Engineering Manager position in the Operations Department at Grade 18 Step 1.** Upon vote being taken, the motion carried unanimously.


Motion was made by Frankenfeld and seconded by Winkler **to approve the elevation of the following positions: Assistant Food Services Managers, Ticket Operations Manager,**

Assistant Ticket Operations Manager, Operations Manager, Engineering Manager and Life Safety & Events Coordinator to Grade 18 due to the governed mandated overtime rule effective December 1, 2016. Upon vote being taken, the motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Frankenfeld and seconded by Bailie **to elevate the following positions: Ticket Operations Manager to Grade 18 Step 4, Food Services Manager/Catering Manager to Grade 18 Step 3, Director of Food Services to Grade 19 Step 7, Life Safety and Events Coordinator to Grade 18 Step 20 due to compression issue forced upon the Board by the government mandated overtime rule.** Upon vote being taken, the motion carried unanimously. Board members noted these management positions need to be considered for additional compression relief in future budget cycles.

There being no further business, motion was made by Winkler and seconded by Bailie **to adjourn the meeting.** Upon vote being taken, the motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 9:34 a.m.
