

Understanding Your Utility Bill

- 100 Cubic Feet = 1 Unit of Water
- For Residential with 5/8" meter—0-10 units is \$4.73 per unit, 11-25 units is \$5.05 per unit, 26-50 units is \$5.73 per unit, and greater than 50 units is \$6.56 per unit.
- 100 cubic feet of water is equal to 748 gallons.
- The residential sewer charge is based on your average consumption of water used in the months of December, January and February. It is then calculated at the current rate of \$4.40 per 100 cubic feet of water usage plus demand charge.
- An approximate minimum monthly bill is \$67.00.
- The environmental charge is a state imposed fee.
