SUBJECT: FY2017 DOJ BODY-WORN CAMERA POLICY AND IMPLEMENTATION PROGRAM GRANT

The Rapid City Police Department (RCPD) seeking permission to apply for the FY2017 DOJ Body-Worn Camera (BWC) policy and implementation program grant. The grant would be a partnership program with the Pennington County Sherriff's Office (PCSO).

The DOJ grant is a competitive solicitation, with 10 awards available for agencies of the size of the RCPD and PCSO. The requested grant award would be \$400,000 50% in kind match of \$400,000. Recipients may satisfy this match requirement with either cash or in-kind services such as employee salaries who are supporting the program.

Project period is two years, starting October 1, 2017. If awarded the RCPD and PCSO will be expected to review and develop policies and training programs in the first 9 months. After completion of the policy development process and evaluation, the PIP grantees will be expected to deploy BWCs.
