Subject: Request to be allowed to use Rapid Valley water

Requesting to be allowed to hook our homes off South Valley Drive to Rapid Valley Water supply.

The current route of Rapid City water would cost a minimum of \$250,000 to hook two homes to water. This is due to crossing a creek with service lines. Rapid Valley is considering allowing us to run plastic water line from South Valley Dr. to our homes. There are no obstacles in the way. The water meters would be located on South Valley Dr. and permanent easement would be provided to cross Terry Hook's property with the two separate water lines. The cost of this is drastically less ( figuring approximately \$18,000 total ) and can be accomplished quickly.

Please allow our two properties to be serviced by Rapid Valley Water.

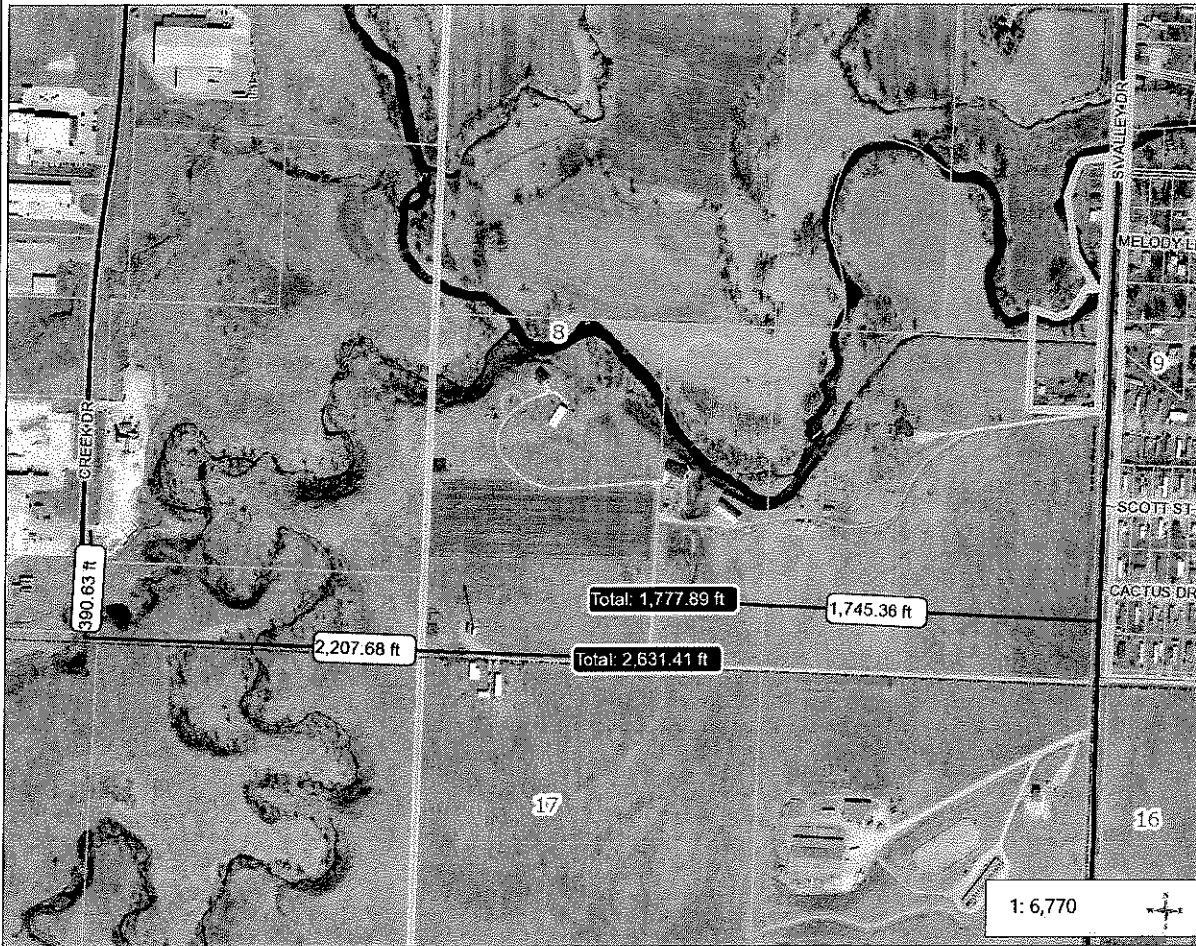
