**SIGN APPLICATIONS**

512 Main Street (17SN002)

Applicant: Rosenbaum's Signs

District: Downtown Commercial District, Contributing - built c.a. 1946

Request: Install 4' x 8' Wall Sign and 2'9" x 2'9" Pedestrian Sign for "Klinkeltown"

Brinkman reviewed the drawings and noted that the proposed signs are similar to the existing signs at Main Street Square. She noted that the background will have a wood like appearance and that the Circle and the letter K will have a neon border. She added that push through letters will be used for the remaining letters and that the letters will be back lit.

**Fenhaus moved to open discussion on the sign application. The motion was seconded by Kingsbury and carried unanimously.**

A brief discussion followed regarding the lighting for the letters.

In response to a question from Kingsbury, Brinkman advised that the pedestrian sign will be installed at the same location as the previous tenant's pedestrian sign.

**Fenhaus moved to approve the installation of the 4' x 8' wall sign and the 2'9" x 2'9" pedestrian sign for "Klinkeltown" at 512 Main Street. The motion was seconded by Kingsbury and carried with Fenhaus and Kingsbury voting yes and Jackson abstaining.**
