



## Parking lot nearly done

The 132-space parking lot at Sixth and Main should be open by the end of the week — "as soon as some concrete parking stops are installed along the old Sears building," said Rapid City Engineer Bill Craig. Parking lot lighting probably will be installed later because of a delay in delivery of materials. This
