



## Parking decals say 'two-hour limit'

Rapid City's downtown businessmen and businesswomen volunteered to put the "two-hour limit" parking decals on the old parking meter posts. Nearly 1,000 parking meter heads have been removed from Main and St. Joseph from Fourth to Ninth streets and the two city-owned downtown parking lots. The two-hour limited parking,

however, remains on all street parking and the lot at Sixth and St. Joseph. Meters will remain on Kansas City and Columbus streets and the library
