



Paving completed on city parking lot

City crews have finished placing a two-inch hot mix asphalt mat on the new "shoppers" parking lot at Sixth and St. Joseph. The next job is to install a concrete walk-island down the center for the meters. The property was acquired by the city for \$152,000 from the parking lot and area fund which

comes from parking meter receipts. Another \$20,000 is going into the leveling, new surface, striping and meters. A side benefit to the 56 parking spaces in the off-street lot is the addition of seven or eight new on-street spaces when the driveway into

the former gas station was closed. The metered lot will have two-hour maximum time with 25 cents for two hours provided the council approves Monday night. It will be opened officially in early November. (Staff photo by Bob Fell)
