## proposed district

The Rapid City Public Parking Board met again Friday afternoon to study the assessed value of property contained in a proposed public parking district. The board met Thursday and will recommend a district considerably larger than one proposed several years ago.

The new district would extend from East Boulevard to West Boulevard and from the alley south of Kansas City Street on the south to Omaha from West Boulevard to Fifth and then to Rapid Street from Fifth to East Boulevard.

The previous district extended only to Fifth Street on the east and to Rapid Street on the north. Expanding the district to the east, the board agreed, would add more property along Main and St. Joe which is developing into a commercial area.

The new district includes county as well as city property which could be subject to assessment.

Purpose of the parking district is to permit levying an assessment against all except one- and two-family residential property within the district for the purpose of financing the acquisition, construction and maintenance of land for off-street parking.

The parking board will recommend going ahead with the parking district to the planning commission and the city council
