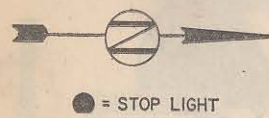

**Rushmore Road parking changed**

The city, in an effort to eliminate traffic congestion on Rushmore Road between Main and Kansas City streets, has ordered all on-street parking stopped on the west side of the street. The chief problems center at Main and St. Joe streets, especially during the heavy tourist season and during the late afternoon when shoppers and workers are all trying to get home. Beginning on Thursday, on-street parking will not be permitted from the alley north of Main Street to the alley south of St. Joseph. This will permit the use of vehicle "storage lanes" for turning and other lanes for straight-through traffic. City Traffic Engineer Duane Genzlinger said the new arrangement should speed up traffic, but it has not been determined whether it will be a permanent arrangement since the state Highway Department is also trying to work out a permanent traffic flow pattern for Rushmore Road. Genzlinger said the street will be marked in addition to overhead signing for a clearer understanding by the driving public. (Directional map by the Rapid City Engineering Department)
