

**Minutes
Historic Sign Review Committee
July 31, 2017**

Fenhaus called the meeting to order at 9:15 a.m.

SIGN APPLICATIONS

615 Main Street (17SN007)

Applicant: Matt Stiener

District: Downtown Commercial District – Contributing (Building c.a. 1919)

Request: Install a 2' x 4' double sided oval or rectangle Pedestrian Sign for Broken Arrow Trading Company. Redwood engraved with logo, illuminated.

Brewer informed the committee that the pedestrian sign will be mounted on the brick pillar located on the east side of the building with an eight foot clearance. She provided an example of the sign and noted that it will have two faces and will be mounted with the arrow bracket similar to the sign in Deadwood as provided in the submitted drawings. She added that the business will not be open after dark so the sign will not be illuminated, and will be attached through the mortar, not the brick.

Fenhaus moved to approve the installation of the 2' x 4' double sided oval pedestrian sign for Broken Arrow Trading Company. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

601 Kansas City Street (17SN008)

Applicant: Sam Papendick

District: Environs of Individually Listed Structure – Non Listed

Request: Install a 30" x 256" Steel Letter Sign for Hay Camp Brewing Company, Backlit.

Hanzel reviewed the request and noted that the structure is not listed but is located in the environs.

Koth advised that the new sign will be located where the previous sign was and that new holes will need to be made to install the sign.

Papendick added that the new sign will be mounted above the aluminum awning and that the letters will be made of steel which will be offset two inches and will be back lit with the lights being mounted on the sign brackets. A brief discussion followed.

In response to a question from Geiger, Papendick explained that the sign is centered as close as possible. He added that the location of the door and the curvature of the building had to be taken into consideration about the placement of the sign.

Geiger moved to approve the installation of the 30" x 256" back lit steel letter sign for Hay Camp Brewing Company. The motion was seconded by Moloney and carried unanimously
