SUBJECT: 2018 Vehicle Purchases

Sgt. Asscherick and I have reviewed the status of our current fleet. Based on our review, we recommend the following purchases to replace aging, high-mileage vehicles in the patrol and administration fleet. This is part of a routine replacement plan to ensure our fleet is safely maintained.

I calculated the state bid prices of the vehicles including options. I went to Liberty Superstores in Rapid City and the dealership agreed to meet or be under the state bid prices. The Dodge Chargers they were able to get the purchase price \$595.00 each below state bid for a total savings of \$4,165 for 7 Chargers below state bid.

These purchases will make a significant positive impact on the condition of the fleet. The state bid and dealer invoices are attached to this memo for your review.

With these purchases several vehicles will be repurposed throughout the department. The final results will be a reduction of 7 vehicles throughout our fleet. This will assist with lower maintenance costs increasing the overall efficiency of the department.
